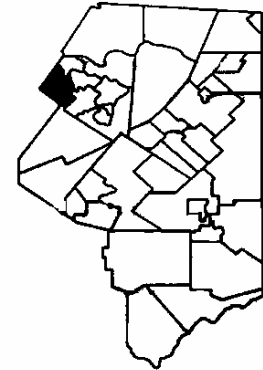


West Abington Township, Lackawanna County
